## **FY 2015-2016 Treasurer's Report, November 2, 2015**

Began period with \$5,895.09

### Operating Account Expenses

- Food & Supplies for Shack \$1,588.27
- Replacement Freezer (22 cubic ft, old freezer died) \$738.95
- \$250 deposit to hold the Desmond for Banquet in January

### Student Fundraising

- Student Fundraiser #2 (Wawa Hoagies) has completed! By the numbers:
  - 48 Students & 2 Faculty sold 2,367 Wawa coupons
  - Total \$2,367 net profit will be added to Student Accounts (in Charms) to apply to future music expenses (e.g. Disney trip!)
  - The top student sold 221 coupons and added \$221 to her student account
  - **A special "Thank You" to Meg Colahan for organizing another very successful student fundraiser this year.**
- 3 Students applied funds toward the Disney trip payment due on October 11 (\$747.00)
- Student Accounts - Balance (total): \$9,731.90

### Income
