 - -- Great turnout at auditions: Select Choir: (28 students); Chamber Orchestra: (60+ students)
 - -- Jazz Band sounds great
- g. HS Choral Director's Report Katie Domizio
 - -- Not present at meeting
- h. Elementary Directors' Report Taylor Harner, Joy Deminski
 - -- 5/6 music spaces have many new, modern features
 - -- Biggest roadblock: not enough budget for more instruments and rug
 - -- 4th through 6th Grades having Will Shafer full time is great
 - -- Taylor will meet with O'Toole about what 5/6 Choir will look like (since now kids begin Choir in 7th grade)
 - -- Joy has 90+ students in 4th Grade orchestra and same number of students for Band
 - -- Student numbers overall are good but scheduling is a challenge (larger groups with mixed instruments); concerned with inadequate time with each student

 - -- Danielle has spoken with music teachers over the past 2 weeks: has organized everyone together to discuss with their District rep about music program
