- b. Treasurer's Report Eileen O'Malley
 - -- Shack net income exceeded budget by approximately \$4,000 this season
 - -- Annual Appeal Campaign is starting to see activity--early in the process--currently running <u>below</u> target of approximately \$9,000 in overall donations
- **c.** Student Leader Reports Taylor Mason, Luca Scott (Tri-M)
 - -- Not present at meeting
- d. Financial Secretary's Report Chris Scott
 - -- <u>Tonino's Dine & Donate (10/23)</u>: was not greatly attended, but GVMPA was able to raise \$200
 - -- Popcorn Sale: first popcorn sale gross was \$2,232; students receive 50%
 - -- Coffee Sale: will begin on 11/10, with distribution will be on 12/7
 - -- Holiday Plant Sale: will begin 11/7 and end before Thanksgiving
- e. High School Instrumental Director's Report Alex Siwa
 - -- Not present at meeting

- f. MS Instrumental Director/Choir Director's Report Greg Dippell
 - -- The choir's big focus so far this year has been progressing in music reading ability; Greg is focusing on note reading, rhythm recognition, and melodic recognition (well-received by the students)
 - -- <u>Choir concert (12/11)</u>: 7th and 8th Grade choir with Select Chorus, three songs each, combined song with everyone at the end; after school rehearsal either 12/9 or 12/10; dress rehearsal on 12/11
 - -- New marking period started today (10/30): new music elective classes began; numbers are still small but definitely going up; Adam Search and Greg are adding exciting new elements to the music elective classes, including higher level concepts of movie and video game orchestration
 - -- <u>7th and 8th Grade orchestras</u>: fantastic numbers and participation in the auditioned groups, select choir and chamber orchestra
 - -- <u>New ensemble--the 8th Grade honors string quartet</u>: rehearse once a week after school, with aim to perform at the instrumental concert in January, as well as at various community events within Malvern's Victorian Christmas
 - -- A new viola ensemble: started this year as well; have the numbers this year to do so and the kids are really excited
 - -- Overall, things are going really well--performance groups are playing at a high level, and the music elective classes have started to populate more; Greg is trying to give the students every chance to play and perform in a smaller group setting, outside of the choir and orchestra; using the viola ensemble as an example, if the numbers and desire is there, Greg strongly believes the children should be given every opportunity to do so; he is taking that approach to the choir as well; have some individuals in the eighth grade who have expressed an interest in a possible jazz vocal group
